There have been many good things going on in Logan's life this past year. She continues to thrive because of the drug, Kalydeco, which was approved for her segment of the CF population.

Logan will begin another clinical trial in April to help find a cure for all those with Cystic Fibrosis that are not currently approved for Kalydeco. Kalydeco is a prescription medicine used for the treatment of cystic fibrosis (CF) in patients age 6 years and older. This drug only benefits children who have one of nine mutations in their CF gene. Because this is a small percentage of CF mutations, ongoing research is crucial. Logan doesn't necessarily like all the blood draws, but she understands how important this research is for all of the other kids waiting for a cure! Studies like this rely on your donations and brave young people like Logan. 90% of every dollar donated goes directly to finding a cure.
